Thomas Dressendörfer has had a progressive career in finance, holding key senior finance positions (CFO of major business units/regions) in several international, publicly listed companies, including Tom Tailor, Straumann, Uster Technologies, Randstad, The Nielsen Company, Procter & Gamble, and Baumüller Nuremberg. His career has thus brought him through the Healthcare, Textile Fashion and Consumer Products industry, as well as the Personnel Services, Market Intelligence, and Mechanical Engineering sectors – in various countries. 2008 he moved to Switzerland and first joined Uster Technologies Ltd, a publicly traded company in the cotton quality testing industry in Switzerland, where he has been for 4 years Chief Financial Officer and a Member of the Executive Committee. During this period Uster Technologies went through a major transformation process regaining previous high profit levels. In the following 4 years he has been Chief Financial Officer and a Member of the Executive Committee with Straumann in Switzerland, a publicly traded company in the dental implant industry, where he has contributed significantly to the past years success. From 2016 until 2020 he led as Chief Financial Officer and as Member of the Executive Committee the restructuring and the turnaround of the Tom Tailor SE in Germany.

Since the beginning of 2016 he started up his own company (www.dcs-consulting.ch) with focus on support for high value and complex business project such as turnaround cases. He brings along as well extensive experience in M&A transactions. He has been and still is in various Supervisory Boards since 2016. He is in the Supervisory Board of the Wolford AG since 2018.
